

SITE Centers Set to Join S&P SmallCap 600

NEW YORK, June 25, 2020 /PRNewswire/ -- SITE Centers Corp. (NYSE: SITC) will replace Mobile Mini Inc. (NASDAQ: MINI) in the S&P SmallCap 600 effective prior to the opening of trading on Wednesday, July 1. WillScot Corp. (NASDAQ: WSC) is acquiring Mobile Mini Inc. in a deal expected to be completed on or about July 1 pending final conditions. Post-merger WillScot Corp will change its name to WillScot Mobile Mini Holdings Corp.

SITE Centers is a REIT that is an owner and manager of open-air shopping centers. Headquartered in Beachwood, OH, the company will be added the S&P SmallCap 600 GICS (Global Industry Classification Standard) Retail REITs Sub-Industry index.
